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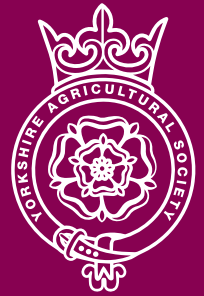

Our courses are run by experienced tutors who have been selected for their quality of delivery and their passion for the outdoors.

Monday 24th September Developing your outdoor space for learning

Suitable for: EYFS, KS1 & KS2

Whether you only have a playground or are overwhelmed with your outdoor area, learn tips and ideas to make the most of what you have. See how you can minimise planning and preparation with a few simple tricks. The focus will be a broad based approach to curriculum learning including STEM activities plus Geography, History and English. We will also look at how to set up simple growing spaces that are effective and easy to manage.

Monday 1st October Building confidence to take the curriculum outdoors

Suitable for: EYFS, KS1 & KS2

Learn how simple it can be to take everyday classroom learning outside through a range of engaging and interactive activities. Boost your confidence, remove perceived barriers and enjoy being outdoors as much as the children! All aspects of the curriculum will be discussed with a focus on cross curricular learning and topic work.

Tuesday 2nd October Muddy maths

Suitable for: EYFS & KS1

Investigate different uses for natural materials and ways to use simple equipment in delivering maths games and activities in the outdoor world. Come along and get ideas for using back at school in wooded areas, on the playing fields and the playground.

Thursday 4th October KS2 Science outdoors

Suitable for: KS2

Enhance your classroom-based science through the introduction and development of large-scale and/or outdoor learning activities. Using games, practical activities and experiments, we will explore various aspects of the KS2 science curriculum, including plants, animals, light, forces and magnets and material properties.

Monday 12th November A different perspective

Suitable for: EYFS & KS1

Ideas for nature discovery activities, using all the senses, such as listening games, mirror walk and smell trail, leading to creative out-door language and literacy ideas.

Tuesday 13th November KS1 Science outdoors

Suitable for: KS1

Enhance your classroom-based science through the introduction and development of large-scale and / or outdoor learning activities. Using games, practical activities and experiments, we will explore various aspects of the KS1 science curriculum, including plants, animals, living things and everyday materials.

Monday 19th November Christmas Crafts

Suitable for: KS2

Simple Christmas crafts from natural materials including stick Santas, willow stars and cork reindeers which would make excellent items to sell at the school fayre or as part of a classroom enterprise project.

Tuesday 27th November Awesome outdoor art

Suitable for: EYFS, KS1 & KS2

This course will enable participants to explore natural materials to create art on the outdoor canvas. Make a range of awesome art pieces including hanging and standing sculptures, collages, and lanterns, whilst exploring links to the national curriculum, topics and stories.

Wednesday 28th November Outdoor maths

Suitable for: KS2

Do you want to explore simple approaches to delivering maths in the outdoors? This course will inspire you with an abundance of practical activities that explore a range of different mathematical skills including measurement, scales, angles, reasoning and shape. Promotes a 'hands on' approach which demonstrates to children that maths is real and relevant

Tuesday 4th December Muddy maths

Suitable for: EYFS & KS1

Investigate different uses for natural materials and ways to use simple equipment in delivering maths games and activities in the outdoor world. Come along and get ideas for using back at school in wooded areas, on the playing fields and on the playground itself.

Wednesday 5th December Campfires & winter outdoor cooking

Suitable for: KS1 & KS2

Experience a range of activities to enable safe campfires to be created and used for cooking. Skills will include setting up a campfire area, including lighting the fire, and maintaining it for cooking purposes. Cook and taste several simple dishes that can be used with groups of children.
