## FARMING CELEBRITIES TAKE CENTRE STAGE AT GREAT YORKSHIRE SHOW

**Big-name farming stars will be part of a brand-new section of the Great Yorkshire Show as the GYS Stage sponsored by Daniel Thwaites is unveiled for the first time ever.**

Adam Henson is the first celebrity to be announced as he takes to the stage on Tuesday July 12 and meets fans afterwards in a meet & greet zone.

The GYS Stage will be a terrific new addition to the Great Yorkshire Show which will feature some new elements as well as old favourites. Expect to see some of the finest animals in the country competing in the ever-popular cattle competitions that will be attracting lots of international interest this year. There will also be some brand-new show jumping classes, a first for the TopSpec White Rose ring. More announcements will be made over the coming weeks.

Adam Henson is one of the UK's best-known farmers and a presenter on BBC1's Countryfile. Further announcements will be made about who will be appearing each day on the new GYS Stage, keep an eye on the website for details. **Members have free entry to the Great Yorkshire Show on every day of the event which is Tuesday July 12 to Friday July 15.**

Adam said: "The Great Yorkshire has a reputation as one of the best agricultural shows in the country. It's not only a showcase for farmers to exhibit some of the finest livestock in the country but also a great day out

for those who want to learn about and enjoy everything rural. I visited many years ago and I'm really looking forward to my day at the show this year."

Former ITV Calendar presenter Christine Talbot will host the GYS Stage, with two interviews a day before an audience of 300. Further announcements will be made in the coming weeks about other farming celebrities who will be appearing.

Christine said: "I'm absolutely thrilled to be hosting this brand new element of the brilliant Great Yorkshire Show. It will be a privilege to chat to the famous faces of the farming world, find out more about them and ask them the questions that our audience want to know. There's a fantastic line up and I hope it will be an important part of the whole experience for the Great Yorkshire Show visitors."

The Great Yorkshire Show has become a four-day event after a raft of changes were implemented at the 2021 show due to Covid 19 regulations.



Tickets are on sale now for the hugely popular Springtime Live, with two new special guests appearing at this year's show on Saturday April 2.

Youngsters can see Peppa Pig who will be making an appearance at Springtime Live and Shaun the Sheep.

From farm animals to fairground rides, all activities are FREE once inside the event which celebrates farming, food and the countryside.

This is a covid safe event with hand sanitisers and restrictions on contact with the animals.

There will be a selection of animals from Ian's Mobile Farm which is based in Aberford near Leeds; including rabbits, goats and sheep.

Supervised alpaca walks will also be available in the showground as well as Ferretworld's Roadshow.

The Rare Breeds Survival Trust will be hosting their Young Shepherd final of the year for the first time as well.

Ripon Farm Services have donated mini tractors which youngsters can ride around an indoor circuit, there will also be an outdoor bike track and a climbing wall.

There will be reptiles and bug encounters as well as forest crafts.

Due to the popularity of Springtime Live, entry is by advance ticket only and there are a limited number on sale.

Springtime Live will be at the Great Yorkshire Showground, in Harrogate, on Saturday April 2, from 9am to 4:30pm. Tickets cost £11 for adults and £7 for children or a family ticket (2 adults and 3 children) for £31. Under 3s are free.
